COMMUNITY GRANTS

We awarded more than \$2000 in community grants in Mongolia in 2016. The funded projects include the "Voices for Equality" concert organized by the LGBT Centre of Mongolia, a teacher's methodology seminar, and a project to improve children's English learning by increasing parental involvement.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Together with the Matthew Girvin Scholarship Fund, we awarded nine university student scholarships for the 2015-2016 school year, totaling nearly \$7000.


For the 2016-2017 school year, we are awarding ten university student scholarships, totaling over \$8000.
